a presentation of work from more than 1,000 artists from over 60 countries – last six years in the field of scenography / performance design - photographs, videos, objects, models and installation, performances, live installations, presentations, lectures, workshops, art walks and fashion shows.

Architecture Section

exhibition, talks and city of Prague related projects on current tendencies within performative architecture.

Student Section

expositions of performing arts – visual arts – architecture schools from all around the world.

What? An exhibition as well as performances, workshops, lectures and discussions - contemporary work from stage design and costume design to lighting design, sound design and new scenographic practices such as site-specific, applied scenography, urban performance, costume as performance ... – the largest event of its kind in the world. Every four year since 1967.

Where? Prague, Czech Republic.

Who? Expositions and exhibiting artists from more than 70 countries; more than 5,000 registered theatre professionals and students + 50,000 other visitors.

Why? PQ 2015 reflects the scenography as shared space - with aim to create a platform for investigation of contemporary scenography; to explore scenography as an interdisciplinary field and an active agent in the creation of spatial/performative/social relationships.

What can you experience?

Objects

experimental, curated exhibition with aim to exhibit props and their stories by video installation.

Makers

artists are invited to make the food design with theatrical theme within live exhibition.

Tribes

experimental addition with living people as artifacts withing the exhibitions' scenography in the public spaces of Prague.

SpaceLab

an educational project of the PQ – an opportunity for students and young artists to meet and exchange ideas among themselves and to interact with top professionals in the field - workshops and performances.
